A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, Our Lady of the Rosary Parish is blessed to welcome home to Saint Pascal Church Father Daniel Maria Klimek, T.O.R to offer a First Mass. A Franciscan friar of the Third Order Regular, Father

Klimek was ordained a priest on July 11, 2020, amid the Covid 19 lockdowns and limitations. Because of the restrictions on social gatherings in place at the time of his ordination, Father Daniel Maria was unable to celebrate a First Mass with friends and family here at Saint Pascal, his family's parish church.

Father Daniel Maria belongs to the Third Order Regular of the Franciscans. Saint Francis of Assisi (died 1226) inspired a movement for living our Catholic faith that has resulted in a family of religious communities that continue his name and legacy, the Franciscans. Among these communities are three primary orders: the Friars Minor, the Poor Clare nuns, and the Third Order Regular. The origins of the Third Order Regular (T.O.R.) predate Saint Francis by several centuries to the Penitential movement of the sixth century, which enabled ordinary men and women to live their lives in the pursuit of holiness. In response to the preaching and ministry of Saint Francis, ordinary men and women from Assisi, building upon the earlier traditions of the Penitential movement, began to support one another in caring for the poor and doing other good works through spiritual practices without leaving their homes, families, and occupations. In 1447, Pope Eugene IV united many of these Franciscan popular movements as the Third Order. As Father Daniel Maria's community reminds us, "the first Franciscans were, in fact, known as "Penitents of Assisi." Men and women who were attracted by Francis' way of life but could not leave their homes and families to become wandering preachers or cloistered nuns, banded together. Thus, the Third Order was born."

By the middle of the Fifteenth century, groups in the Third Order formed more structured communities, including men and women religious who embraced the Church's traditional religious vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. In time, several congregations of lay people and consecrated religious have developed throughout the world. As the members of the Third Order will tell us, in these communities, "the call to conversion and simplicity of life animates the members. In the Secular Franciscan Order, men and women follow the way of Francis, but are not vowed religious living in community. The Third Order Regular, on the other hand, is an international community of priests and brothers who emphasize works of mercy and on-going conversion to the Gospel." Father Daniel Maria belongs to the Sacred Heart Province of the Third Order Regular, also known as the Franciscan Friars, TOR. The original members of Father Daniel Maria's Sacred Heart Province of the Franciscan Friars, TOR came to the United States from Ireland in 1847 at the invitation of the Bishop of Pittsburgh, where they founded a school in Loretto, PA, which would become Saint Francis University. Father Daniel was ordained to the priesthood in the athletic center of Saint Francis University. Because of the social distancing requirements at the time, the athletic center was the only possible venue for holding the event. But, as Father Daniel Maria notes, given his love of sports, it was not entirely inappropriate.

The Sacred Heart Province of the Franciscan Friars, TOR also sponsors the University of Steubenville, where Father Daniel Maria serves on the faculty.

We are so incredibly grateful to welcome Father Daniel Maria Klimek, TOR home to Saint Pascal Church. We are so very blessed to have him offer a "First Mass" in our sanctuary.

A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE



Queridos feligreses,

Este fin de semana, la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario tiene la bendición de dar la bienvenida a casa a la Iglesia de San Pascal al Padre Daniel María Klimek, T.O.R para ofrecer una Primera Misa. Fraile franciscano de la Tercera Orden

Regular, el padre Klimek fue ordenado sacerdote el 11 de julio de 2020, en medio de los bloqueos y limitaciones de Covid 19. Debido a las restricciones a las reuniones sociales vigentes en el momento de su ordenación, el Padre Daniel María no pudo celebrar una Primera Misa con amigos y familiares aquí en St. Pascal, la iglesia parroquial de su familia.

El Padre Daniel María pertenece a la Tercera Orden Regular de los Franciscanos. San Francisco de Asís (muerto en 1226) inspiró un movimiento para vivir nuestra fe católica que ha dado lugar a una familia de comunidades religiosas que continúan su nombre y legado, los franciscanos. Entre estas comunidades hay tres órdenes primarias: los Frailes Menores, las monjas Clarisas y la Tercera Orden Regular. Los orígenes de la Tercera Orden Regular (T.O.R.) son anteriores a San Francisco por varios siglos al movimiento penitencial del siglo VI, que permitió a los hombres y mujeres comunes vivir sus vidas en la búsqueda de la santidad. En respuesta a la predicación y el ministerio de San Francisco, los hombres y mujeres comunes de Asís, basándose en las tradiciones anteriores del movimiento penitencial, comenzaron a apoyarse mutuamente en el cuidado de los pobres y en hacer otras buenas obras a través de prácticas espirituales sin abandonar sus hogares, familias y ocupaciones. En 1447, el Papa Eugenio IV unió muchos de estos movimientos populares franciscanos como la Tercera Orden. Como nos recuerda la comunidad del Padre Daniel María, "los primeros franciscanos fueron, de hecho, conocidos como "Penitentes de Asís". Hombres y mujeres que se sintieron atraídos por la forma de vida de Francisco, pero que no podían dejar sus hogares y familias para convertirse en predicadores errantes o monjas de clausura, se unieron. Así

nació la Tercera Orden. "

A mediados del siglo XV, los grupos de la Tercera Orden formaron comunidades más estructuradas, incluidos religiosos y religiosas que abrazaron los votos religiosos tradicionales de la Iglesia de pobreza, castidad y obediencia. Con el tiempo, varias congregaciones de laicos y religiosos consagrados se han desarrollado en todo el mundo. Como nos dirán los miembros de la Tercera Orden, en estas comunidades, "la llamada a la conversión y a la sencillez de vida anima a los miembros. En la Orden Franciscana Seglar, los hombres y las mujeres siguen el camino de Francisco, pero no son religiosos votados que viven en comunidad. El Tercer Orden Regular, por otro lado, es una comunidad internacional de sacerdotes y hermanos que enfatizan las obras de misericordia y la conversión continua al Evangelio. El Padre Daniel María pertenece a la Provincia del Sagrado Corazón de la Tercera Orden Regular, también conocida como los Frailes Franciscanos, TOR. Los miembros originales de la Provincia del Sagrado Corazón del Padre Daniel María de los Frailes Franciscanos, TOR llegaron a los Estados Unidos desde Irlanda en 1847 por invitación del Obispo de Pittsburgh, donde fundaron una escuela en Loretto, PA, que se convertiría en la Universidad de San Francisco. El Padre Daniel fue ordenado sacerdote en el centro atlético de San Vicente. Universidad Francis. Debido a los requisitos de distanciamiento social en ese momento, el centro atlético era el único lugar posible para celebrar el evento. Pero, como señala el padre Daniel María, dado su amor por el deporte, no fue del todo inapropiado.

La Provincia del Sagrado Corazón de los Frailes Franciscanos, TOR también patrocina la Universidad de Steubenville, donde el Padre Daniel María sirve en la facultad.

Estamos increíblemente agradecidos de dar la bienvenida al Padre Daniel María Klimek, TOR hogar de St. Pascal Church. Estamos muy bendecidos de que ofrezca una "Primera Misa" en nuestro santuario.

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY MUSIC MINISTRY

Recently, Dominick Maino, a member of the Saint Bartholomew was interviewed by a WBEZ NPR radio metro reporter, Adora Namigadde. This was broadcasted nationally on June 5 with the Our Lady of the Rosary choir singing in the background.

Listed below are a few excerpts from the interview.

COVID has changed the way people worship. A recent study showed even though many churches are now offering in-person services, people aren't returning to pre-pandemic attendance. Among Catholic churches in Chicago, this is compounding a problem they already had. They're losing people. Many parishes there have been forced to close or merge. Members are coming to terms with this new normal. From member station WBEZ, Adora Namigadde reports.

ADORA NAMIGADDE, BYLINE: Since her parish closed, 30-year-old Rosie Dominguez (ph) has been hopping around different churches around Chicago. None feel like the church she grew up attending.

ROSIE DOMINGUEZ: I have conversations with my father. He's like, Rosie, you know, the church is just, you know, the body of the people. I'm like, I understand that, but - and, yes, I know I can worship elsewhere, but it's just not the same.

NAMIGADDE: There are a third fewer parishes in Chicago today than there were five years ago. Recently, people are questioning the value of institutional religion on the whole. Catholicism is especially vulnerable. Michael Budde teaches Catholic studies at DePaul University.

MICHAEL BUDDE: You've got the pedophilia scandals. You have people who are not comfortable with a male-only clergy, for example.

NAMIGADDE: Budde also blames these recent church closures in part on the previous generation.

BUDDE: Most Catholic parents don't necessarily do a good job of not just teaching in a kind of - an informational sense, but modeling the kinds of practices that might allow their children to see that this is a defensible or an appealing way to live one's life.

NAMIGADDE: Budde says effectively modeling the faith could mean creating a series of practices and activities in

the home. Things like praying as a family, volunteering or going to youth groups together promote faith. Punching in and out of church for Sunday Mass doesn't cut it.

JASON MALAVE: The number of priests, it was not increasing.

NAMIGADDE: Father Jason Malave is with the Archdiocese of Chicago. He says church leadership there consolidated in order to make the most of the parish's dwindling resources.

MALAVE: The number of the faithful at Mass on Sunday was not increasing. People's generosity to the parishes was not increasing. The only thing that was increasing was the amount of money that it cost to maintain the buildings, all the campuses that we find ourselves serving people on.

NAMIGADDE: There are some areas of the country where Catholicism is growing, mostly in the South. But closures are widespread across the East and Midwest. Not all members are upset about these changes.

UNIDENTIFIED CHOIR: (Singing in non-English language).

NAMIGADDE: Dominic Manos (ph) has been singing in the choir at St. Bartholomew Parish in Chicago for more than two decades. The parish merged with two others this year in an initiative called Renew My Church. He says with more people, the choir sounds beautiful, and it's meant new relationships.

DOMINIC MANOS: One of our folks who came from another parish was naturally upset about what happened with Renew My Church. And I certainly commiserated with him. But then I said, you know, all that turmoil brought you to us, and that put a smile on his face.

NAMIGADDE: He hopes ultimately making his parish more robust will attract more people.

MANOS: What makes what has happened to us possible and even tolerable and make us more accepting of it is that we're doing it slowly. We're doing it so that we bring people together.

NAMIGADDE: But being Catholic, Manos says, takes patience. It literally takes faith. For NPR News, I'm Adora Namigadde in Chicago.

BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY



Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure.



SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents and godparents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office or website.

RECONCILIATION: Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades, if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceanera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.

PREPARACIÓN SACRAMENTAL

BAUTISMOS: El registro en la parroquia es un requisito previo. Los padres deben asistir a una sesión de preparación pre-bautismal con el celebrante dos meses antes del bautismo, ya sea en persona o por Zoom. RECONCILIACIÓN: Todos los sábados a las 9:00 AM en San Pascal y San Bartolomé.

SACRAMENTO DEL MATRIMONIO: Ya sea la novia, el novio o el padre de cualquiera de los dos debe ser un feligrés registrado y activo al menos seis meses antes de ponerse en contacto con la parroquia para hacer arreglos. Para la preparación previa al matrimonio y para asegurar la fecha de la boda que prefiera, por favor llame a la oficina parroquial por lo menos seis meses de anticipación antes de confirmar el salón de recepción. Los arreglos se pueden hacer en la Oficina Parroquial por los novios.

COMUNIÓN, CONFIRMACIÓN Y CONVERSIÓN:

Niños: Todos los niños deben estar inscritos en el Programa de Educación Religiosa de primero a octavo grado si no están en una escuela católica.

Adultos: Por favor llame a la oficina parroquial para preguntar acerca de RICA (Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos).

SACRAMENTO DE ENFERMO: Cada vez que una persona se enfrenta a una enfermedad grave, cirugía u hospitalización, es apropiado recibir el Sacramento del Enfermo. Por favor, póngase en contacto con la oficina parroquial. Si la oficina está cerrada, por favor deje un mensaje en el correo de voz de un sacerdote.

MINISTERIO DE CUIDADO - FELIGRESES CONFINADOS EN CASA:

Por favor, notifique a la oficina parroquial que hay alguien que usted conoce que no puede unirse a nosotros en la Misa y le gustaría que la Eucaristía se lleva a su casa. Nuestros Ministros de Cuidado llevan la Sagrada Comunión a aquellos que están enfermos y confinados en casa.

FUNERALES: Cuando un miembro de la familia muere, los arreglos con la Iglesia generalmente son hechos por la Funeraria. También se puede hacer contacto con la parroquia directamente para que los sacerdotes y los ministros de duelo puedan ayudar en la planificación de la liturgia para la Misa Funeral, el Servicio de Velatorio y la Encomienda Final en el cementerio.

QUINCE AÑOS O DULCES DIECISÉIS: Las jóvenes de dieciséis o quince años que deseen celebrar su quinceañera deberán haber sido Confirmadas y haber recibido su Primera Comunión, así como una serie de preparación para la celebración. Por favor llame a la Sra. María Arrez en la Oficina de Educación Religiosa para más detalles.

PRESENTACIÓN DE UN NIÑO: Cuando su hijo tiene 40 días o tres años de edad, él / ella puede ser presentado en la iglesia el primer domingo de cualquier mes. Por favor llame a la oficina parroquial una semana antes para registrar a su hijo.
