A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE



On Thursday, July 21, 2022, Cardinal Cupich, Archbishop of Chicago, issued a decree that relegates the Church of Our Lady of Victory to “profane, but not sordid use.” This antiquated language from Church law means the building is no longer considered to be sacred space set aside for divine worship and the celebration of the sacraments. As you may know, even after the regular celebration of Sunday and daily Mass ended last fall, we continued to open Our Lady of Victory to families hoping to celebrate a wedding, baptism, or funeral there. I truly regret that we are no longer able to do so.

Please see the decree on pages 3-5 of today’s bulletin.

You will note that toward the end of the decree, the Cardinal states that “before hierarchical recourse (appeal) may be taken against this decree, a written, signed, and dated petition must be sent or delivered to the Archbishop of Chicago within ten (10) useful days from the notification of the decree, that is, the date of publication on the Archdiocesan website, July 21, 2022. The tenth “useful” day is August 1, 2022.

My heart goes out to all who grieve the loss of Our Lady of Victory Church.

DECREE

IN THE NAME OF GOD. AMEN.

On January 28, 2021, following consultation with the Presbyteral Council of the Archdiocese of Chicago, I issued a decree extinguishing Our Lady of Victory Parish, St. Bartholomew Parish, and St. Pascal Parish, all on the Northside of the City of Chicago, uniting them in one new territorial parish called, *ad Interim*, Our Lady of Victory and SS. Bartholomew and Pascal Parish. The union was effective July 1, 2021. By decree dated June 3, 2021, it was determined that the new parish would be named Our Lady of the Rosary Parish. A petition for hierarchical recourse against the decree of January 28, 2021, was rejected before the Congregation for the Clergy on July 10, 2021 (Prot. N. 2021 1792).

On December 17, 2021, the Reverend Michael W. O'Connell, pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish, after consulting his parishioners, discerned the continued use of Our Lady of Victory Church for worship was no longer feasible for the new Our Lady of the Rosary Parish. Consequently, he wrote to me and the Episcopal Vicar for his region of the archdiocese, asking that Our Lady of Victory Church be relegated to profane but not sordid use (CIC c. 1222 §2).

A church may be relegated to profane but not sordid use when, after hearing the presbyteral council, the diocesan bishop determines there is a "grave cause" indicating a church should no longer be used for divine worship and that the good of souls suffers no detriment from the relegation. A Definitive Sentence of the College of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura given May 4, 1996, considered what constituted the grave cause required for the relegation to profane but not sordid use of a church belonging to a parish formed from the union of parishes (*Ministerium Iustitiae: Jurisprudence of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura*, Montreal: W & L (2011): Prot. N. 24388/93 CA, pp. 526-527).

As related in the Definitive Sentence, a new parish formed from the extinctive union of five parishes sought to relegate three of its five churches to profane but not sordid use. Faithful who worshipped at one of these churches took recourse against the relegation of their church. The Supreme Tribunal found that the following conditions together constituted the grave cause required for relegation: (1) preservation of all the churches would impose an intolerable burden on the new parish; (2) the church in question was no longer of service to the pastoral care of the faithful due to changed circumstances; (3) the new parish was burdened from the beginning by a huge debt; (4) sale of the church would offer ready and effective assistance, otherwise lacking, to the urgent needs of the new parish; (5) the number of faithful contributing to the support of the parish was diminishing; and (6) charity and other assistance to the poor should not be neglected to preserve a sacred building.

In this case it is established that (1) Retaining Our Lady of Victory Church of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish as a place of divine worship, imposes a financial burden on the parish from operational and maintenance expenses associated with the church. If kept for parish

use, the Our Lady of Victory Church campus will require \$1,100,000.00 in capital repairs, more than \$350,000.00 for the church alone. Moreover, Our Lady of the Rosary Parish will have the burden of the ordinary annual expenses for maintaining a church.

(2) Our Lady of Victory Church is not needed for divine worship for the average of 487 Sunday worshippers regularly attending there in October 2019, before the arrival of the novel coronavirus pandemic of COVID-19. Those who worshipped at Our Lady of Victory Church are now well accommodated at the 1,200-seat parish church of St. Pascal, the 800-seat St. Bartholomew Church.

(3) On December 31, 2021, the combined debt of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish was \$2,787,542.00, offset by savings of \$499,595.00 on deposit.

(4) Sale or rental of Our Lady of Victory Church would benefit the mission of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish with ready cash proceeds. There will be immediate additional savings from unspent capital repairs and at least \$175,000.00 annually for maintenance.

(5) The total number of faithful regularly worshipping on Sundays at Our Lady of Victory Church was 487 in October 2019 (Fiscal Year 2020), an almost 50% decrease over the 967 attending in October 2004 (Fiscal Year 2005). Over the same 15-year period, the average offertory collections decreased by \$180,470.00, almost 34% (from 532,511 to 352,041).

(6) Preserving Our Lady of Victory Church for divine worship will result in continued and unnecessary operational and maintenance costs that will cripple the ability of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish to serve the poor, enhance its evangelical mission, and remain viable.

Finally, since March 2020, the novel coronavirus pandemic of COVID-19 has diminished parts of the United States economy, materially and negatively changing the financial well-being of the archdiocese, some of our parishes, and many poor and middle-class families. There is concern for the long-term economic survival of some institutions.

It is unreasonable to expect a new parish formed from the union of three parishes to continue maintaining a church it cannot afford, does not need, and which is no longer useful for divine worship. There are no parochial, archdiocesan, or other known sources of funds available to keep and maintain Our Lady of Victory Church as a place of Catholic worship, and no qualified buyer willing to do so. Moreover, there is no governmental assistance for building or maintaining churches in the United States of America.

The reasonable and safe course is to relegate the church to profane but not sordid use, allowing it to be sold or otherwise developed for the benefit of the new parish, its ministries, and the work of charity.

THEREFORE, know that I, Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, Archbishop of Chicago, according to the norms of the Code of Canon Law, convened the Presbyteral Council of the Archdiocese of

Chicago electronically via the internet on January 17, 2022, and again on January 18, 2022. Hearing the council's deliberations and the council's January 18th vote of 31 for and one against the proposal to relegate Our Lady of Victory Church of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish to profane but not sordid use; invoking the Holy Spirit; satisfying myself that the good of souls will suffer no detriment, and that the parish church of St. Pascal and St. Bartholomew Church are sufficient for the needs of the parish,

I decree the following:


1. Effective immediately, Our Lady of Victory Church of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish on the Northside of the City of Chicago is relegated to profane but not sordid use;
2. Officials of the Archdiocese of Chicago, cooperating with the pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish will assure the real property associated with Our Lady of Victory Church is secure for the benefit of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish;
3. If alienated, the alienation of Our Lady of Victory Church is to provide Our Lady of the Rosary Parish with the proceeds from sale of the real property or rental under lease;
4. When approved, the reports given to the Presbyteral Council on this matter, together with the minutes of the council meetings of January 17, 2022, and January 18, 2022, are to be attached to this decree and available upon request to eligible parties; and
5. Notification of this decree is to be made immediately through publication on the Archdiocesan Website. It is then to be sent to the Pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish for communication to parishioners through publication in the parish bulletin or other suitable means

Before hierarchical recourse (appeal) may be taken against this decree, a written, signed, and dated petition to reconsider or amend the decree must be sent or delivered to the Archbishop of Chicago within ten (10) useful days from notification of the decree (CIC cc. 1734, 1735, 1737). SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents and godparents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office or website.

RECONCILIATION: Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades, if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceañera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.
