A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE UNA PALABRA DEL PADRE MIKE

It is with great joy that we welcome our new Vicar, Bishop Kevin Birmingham, to Our Lady of the Rosary Parish. At the 10:00 AM Mass offered in Saint Pascal Church, Bishop Birmingham will formally inaugurate Our Lady of the Rosary Parish and receive my Profession of Faith as Pastor of the united parish. Out of an abundance of caution, we have downscaled this celebration of inauguration and pastoral installation. A much simpler reception than what we may have offered a visiting bishop will follow the Mass; however the Holy Name societies, the Women's Guild, and the Guadalupanos have promised a tasty treat of hot dogs and tamales. Of course, we would like to have provided Bishop Kevin the opportunity to offer Holy Mass in the three sanctuaries that grace our parish. We will invite him back to participate in other events that grace the calendar of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish.

Bishop Birmingham hails from the southwestern suburbs of Chicago. Early on in his life, the bishop discerned the stirrings of a vocation. He attended Quigley South High School Seminary, working odd jobs to pay the transformation costs involved. He stepped away from the seminary system after Quigley, attending Loyola University; but in his third year at Loyola, he transferred to the Niles College Seminary program of Loyola University. After graduation from the college seminary, Bishop Kevin was enrolled at the Mundelein Seminary of Saint Mary of the Lake. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1997 and served his first assignment at Saint Benedict Parish in Blue Island and its Mission of Saint Peter Claver in Robbins. From 2001 to 2005, Bishop Kevin served as the associate pastor of Saint Francis of Assisi Parish in Orland Park, and from 2005 to 2011, the Bishop served as pastor of Saint Anne Parish in Hazel Crest. In 2011, Bishop Kevin was named pastor of Maternity BVM Parish in Chicago, where he happily served until Cardinal Cupich asked him to be his Administrative secretary in 2014. in 2020. Pope Francis nominated him to serve as an Auxiliary Bishop to the Cardinal. With Bishop Joseph Perry and Bishop John Manz serving as co-consecrators, Cardinal Cupich ordained Bishop Birmingham at Holy Name Cathedral on November 13, 2020, the Feast of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini.

We are so grateful to Bishop Kevin Birmingham for his presence today. We look forward to many happy years under his leadership in ministry in Vicariate IV.

Es con gran alegría que damos la bienvenida a nuestro nuevo Vicario, el Obispo Kevin Birmingham, a la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario. En la Misa de las 10:00 AM ofrecida en la Iglesia de San Pascal, el Obispo Birmingham inaugurará formalmente la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario y recibirá mi Profesión de Fe como Pastor de la parroquia unida. Por precaución, hemos reducido esta celebración de inauguración e instalación pastoral. Una recepción mucho más simple de lo que podemos haber ofrecido a un obispo visitante seguirá a la Misa; sin embargo, las sociedades del Santo Nombre, el Gremio de Mujeres y los Guadalupanos han prometido un sabroso manjar de perritos calientes y tamales. Por supuesto, nos gustaría haber brindado al Obispo Kevin la oportunidad de ofrecer la Santa Misa en los tres santuarios que adornan nuestra parroquia. Lo invitaremos de nuevo a participar en otros eventos que adornan el calendario de la Parroquia Nuestra Señora del Rosario.

El obispo Birmingham proviene de los suburbios del suroeste de Chicago. Al principio de su vida, el obispo discernió los estímulos de una vocación. Asistió al Seminario de Quigley South High School, trabajando en trabajos ocasionales para pagar los costos de transformación involucrados. Se alejó del sistema de seminarios después de Quigley, asistiendo a la Universidad Loyola; pero en su tercer año en Loyola, se transfirió al programa niles College Seminary de la Universidad Loyola. Después de graduarse del seminario universitario, el obispo Kevin se inscribió en el Seminario Mundelein de Santa María del Lago. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1997 y sirvió su primera asignación en la parroquia de San Benito en Blue Island y su misión de San Pedro Claver en Robbins. De 2001 a 2005, el obispo Kevin se desempeñó como pastor asociado de la parroquia de San Francisco de Asís en Orland Park, y de 2005 a 2011, el obispo se desempeñó como párroco de la parroquia de Santa Ana en Hazel Crest. En 2011, el obispo Kevin fue nombrado párroco de la parroquia Maternity BVM en Chicago, donde sirvió felizmente hasta que el cardenal Cupich le pidió que fuera su secretario administrativo en 2014. en 2020. El Papa Francisco lo nominó para servir como Obispo Auxiliar del Cardenal. Con el obispo Joseph Perry y el obispo John Manz sirviendo como co-consagrantes, el cardenal Cupich ordenó al obispo Birmingham en la Catedral del Santo Nombre el 13 de noviembre de 2020, la fiesta de Santa Francisca Xavier Cabrini.

Estamos muy agradecidos al Obispo Kevin Birmingham por su presencia hoy. Esperamos muchos años felices bajo su liderazgo en el ministerio en el Vicariato IV.



SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office.

RECONCILIATION: Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message on a priest's voicemail.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceanera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.

PREPARACIÓN SACRAMENTAL
