

A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE



Dear Parishioners,

As you know, the Bishops of the United States have recently called us to participate in a Eucharistic Revival, directing us to cooperate with God's grace in a powerful renewal in our celebration of the Mass and our devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament. In the Archdiocese of Chicago, Auxiliary Bishop Jeffrey Grob inaugurated the Eucharistic Revival with a spirited celebration of the Mass at Holy Name Cathedral on the Vigil of the Solemnity of Corpus Christi and an outdoor procession with the Blessed Sacrament. The news coverage of the event brought to my mind of the response of our former Associate Pastor, Padre Jesus, and our beloved Deacon Jaime

Rios, to the lockdown. Those who live near the Saint Bartholomew campus of our parish may recall Padre Jesus and Deacon Jaime driving the neighborhood in the back of a truck, blessing people with the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the monstrance they held. Because of the lockdown restrictions, people could not receive the Blessed Sacrament. But, thanks to Padre Jesus and Deacon Jaime, they were able to receive the Eucharistic blessing.

I am profoundly grateful to the Mater Christi Council of the Knights of Columbus for bringing to Our Lady of the Rosary Parish the exhibition created by Blessed Carlo Acutis on Eucharistic miracles. The exhibition is set up in the lower chapel and hospitality below Saint Bartholomew Church. Please visit the exhibit after any of the weekend liturgies.

The exhibition of the Eucharistic miracles is the labor of love of Blessed Carlo, born to Italian parents in London, England in 1991. Although Blessed Carlo lived only fifteen years, his skills at computer programming enabled him to create this exhibit before his untimely death from leukemia in 2006. On Oct. 10, 2020, a young Italian named Carlo Acutis was beatified at a special Mass in the city of Assisi, putting the late teenager just one step away from sainthood. Blessed Carlo rests in the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore in Assisi. But hosting his exhibit in our parish brings him closer to us. May his great passion for the Eucharist awaken in us all greater devotion to Our Lord ever present in the Blessed Sacrament.

PERSISTENCE

Exodus recounts the journey of the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt to the land promised to their ancestors. It was not an easy journey. In today's reading, they are attacked by Amalek and his soldiers, members of one of the peoples who live in the land through which the Israelites are traveling. Moses was on the hilltop with his arms raised to invoke the Lord's assistance in the battle below, a powerful illustration of the Lord's favor upon Israel. If the soldiers were to lift up their eyes to that hill (see Psalm 121:1), they would be reassured by Moses's presence and posture. Paul urges the Thessalonians to persist in proclaiming the gospel, and Jesus likewise commends the widow for her persistence in pursuit of the justice due her. Whether they preach or pray, the followers of Jesus need persistence through periods of difficulty.

Como saben, los obispos de los Estados Unidos nos han llamado recientemente a participar en un Avivamiento Eucarístico, dirigiéndonos a cooperar con la gracia de Dios en una poderosa renovación en nuestra celebración de la Misa y nuestra devoción a la Presencia Real de Jesucristo en el Santísimo Sacramento. En la Arquidiócesis de Chicago, el Obispo Auxiliar Jeffrey Grob inauguró el Avivamiento Eucarístico con una animada celebración de la Misa en la Catedral del Santo Nombre en la Vigilia de la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi y una procesión al aire libre con el Santísimo Sacramento. La cobertura noticiosa del evento me trajo a la mente la respuesta de nuestro ex Pastor Asociado, el Padre Jesús, y nuestro

querido Diácono Jaime Ríos, al encierro. Aquellos que viven cerca del campus de San Bartolomé de nuestra parroquia pueden recordar al Padre Jesús y al Diácono Jaime conduciendo el vecindario en la parte trasera de un camión, bendiciendo a las personas con el Santísimo Sacramento expuesto en la custodia que sostenían. Debido a las restricciones de confinamiento, las personas no podían recibir el Santísimo Sacramento. Pero, gracias al Padre Jesús y al Diácono Jaime, pudieron recibir la bendición eucarística.

Estoy profundamente agradecido al Consejo Mater Christi de Caballeros de Colón por traer a la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario la exposición creada por el Beato Carlo Acutis sobre milagros eucarísticos. La exposición se instala en la capilla inferior y la hospitalidad debajo de la iglesia de San Bartolomé. Por favor, visite la exposición después de cualquiera de las liturgias de fin de semana.

La exposición de los milagros eucarísticos es la obra de amor del Beato Carlo, nacido de padres italianos en Londres, Inglaterra, en 1991. Aunque el Beato Carlo vivió solo quince años, sus habilidades en programación de computadoras le permitieron crear esta exhibición antes de su prematura muerte por leucemia en 2006. Beato Carlo Acutis el 10 de octubre de 2020. El Beato Carlo descansa en la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor de Asís. Pero organizar su exposición en nuestra parroquia lo acerca más a nosotros. Que su gran pasión por la Eucaristía despierte en todos nosotros una mayor devoción a Nuestro Señor siempre presente en el Santísimo Sacramento.

El libro del Éxodo narra el viaje de los israelitas desde la esclavitud en Egipto hasta la tierra prometida a sus antepasados. No fue un viaje fácil. En la lectura de hoy, son atacados por Amalec y sus soldados, integrantes de uno de los pueblos que habitaba por donde pasaron los israelitas. Moisés estaba en la cima de la montaña con los brazos levantados para invocar la ayuda del Señor en la batalla que estaba ocurriendo colina abajo, un ejemplo poderoso del favor del Señor sobre Israel. Si los soldados estuvieran con sus ojos hacia la colina (ver salmo 121:1), se sentirían tranquilos por la presencia y postura de Moisés. Pablo insta a los tesalonicenses a que perseveren en la proclamación del Evangelio, y Jesús elogia igualmente a la viuda por su persistencia en la búsqueda de la justicia que le corresponde. Ya sea que prediquen u oren, los seguidores de Jesús necesitan de la perseverancia en los períodos de dificultad.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents and godparents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office or website.

RECONCILIATION: Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades, if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceañera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.


