

## A WORD FROM FATHER MIKE



Dear Parishioners,

With this weekend's celebration of the First Sunday of Advent, the new liturgical Year of Grace 2023 begins. Much like the celebration of the secular New Year, the start of a new liturgical year marks both the end and the new beginnings of matters spiritual and liturgical.

As we announced previously, the observation of the First Sunday of Advent this year marks the end of the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass that was granted to us at the beginning of the lockdown caused by Covid 19. As you know, the Third Commandment, "You shall keep holy the Sabbath" obliges all Catholics to attend Mass on all Sundays and Days of Precept, that is, Holy Days of Obligation. Failure to do so carries the penalty of sin. Cardinal Cupich, the Archbishop of the local Church, has the authority and pastoral responsibility to loosen and to bind. To keep us safe, the Cardinal used that authority to dispense us from the obligation of being physically present for the Mass during the lockdown. But to keep us spiritually strong during those challenging days, he urged us to participate in the Mass by watching it livestreamed or broadcast on television. We were blessed to have parishioners at both of our churches who worked extremely hard to bring us both in English and Spanish the livestreamed Mass. The Cardinal himself, in partnership with Channel 7, broadcasted the Mass each Sunday from Holy Name Cathedral. At one point during the lockdown, the Cardinal's Sunday Mass became the most watched television program offered by the major networks in Chicago. But now the Cardinal asks us to return to Church for the Mass. In his communication, the Cardinal observes that those with special health concerns continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. In all things, safety first!

To honor the end of the general dispensation and mark the beginning of the return of many to Mass, the Cardinal has asked us to observe the renewal of our baptismal vows and to make use of the rite of sprinkling the congregation with Holy Water this first Sunday of Advent.

With the publication of the New Roman Missal ten years ago, the former practice of blessing the Advent wreath and lighting its first candle at the beginning of Mass was altered, joining that ritual to the Universal Prayer or Prayers of the Faithful. However, because of the insertion of the renewal of baptismal vows and sprinkling rite into the liturgy after the homily, the Archdiocese suggests that this year, we relocate the blessing of the Advent wreath to the start of the Mass. As always, the Gloria is omitted on all the Sundays of Advent and Lent.

During the new liturgical Year of Grace, 2023, we will read from the Sunday Lectionary cycle of Year A and the Year 1 from the weekday lectionary.

Blessed Advent to All!

## UNA PALABRA DEL PADRE MIKE

Estimados feligreses,

Con la celebración este fin de semana del Primer Domingo de Adviento, comienza el nuevo Año Litúrgico de Gracia 2023. Al igual que la celebración del Año Nuevo secular, el comienzo de un nuevo año litúrgico marca tanto el final como el nuevo comienzo de los asuntos espirituales y litúrgicos.

Como anunciamos anteriormente, la observación del Primer Domingo de Adviento de este año marca el final de la dispensa de la obligación de asistir a la misa dominical que se nos otorgó al comienzo del encierro causado por el Covid 19. Como sabéis, el tercer mandamiento, "Santificarás el sábado" obliga a todos los católicos a asistir a Misa todos los domingos y días de precepto, es decir, días santos de obligación. El no hacerlo conlleva la pena del pecado. El cardenal Cupich, arzobispo de la Iglesia local, tiene la autoridad y la responsabilidad pastoral de aflojar y atar. Para mantenernos a salvo, el cardenal usó esa autoridad para dispensarnos de la obligación de estar físicamente presentes para la misa durante el encierro. Pero para mantenernos espiritualmente fuertes durante esos días difíciles, Él nos instó a participar en la Misa viéndolo transmitido en vivo o transmitido por televisión. Tuvimos la bendición de tener feligreses en nuestras dos iglesias que trabajaron muy duro para traernos tanto en inglés como en español la misa transmitida en vivo. El propio cardenal, en asociación con el Canal 7, transmitió la misa todos los domingos desde la Catedral del Santo Nombre cada domingo. En un momento durante el cierre, la misa dominical del cardenal se convirtió en el programa de televisión más visto ofrecido por las principales redes en Chicago. Pero ahora el cardenal nos pide que volvamos a la Iglesia para la Misa. En su comunicación, el cardenal observa que las personas con problemas especiales de salud siguen estando dispensadas de la obligación de asistir a misa. En todas las cosas, ¡la seguridad es lo primero!

Para honrar el final de la dispensación general y marcar el comienzo del regreso de muchos a la Misa, el Cardenal nos ha pedido que observemos la renovación de nuestros votos bautismales y que hagamos uso del rito de rociar a la congregación con agua bendita este primer domingo de Adviento.

Con la publicación del Nuevo Misal Romano hace diez años, se alteró la antigua práctica de bendecir la corona de Adviento y encender su primera vela al comienzo de la Misa, uniendo ese ritual a la Oración Universal u Oraciones de los Fieles. Sin embargo, debido a la inserción de la renovación de los votos bautismales y el rito de aspersión en la liturgia después de la homilía, la Arquidiócesis sugiere que este año, traslademos la bendición de la corona de Adviento al comienzo de la Misa. Como siempre, el Gloria se omite todos los domingos de Adviento y Cuaresma.

Durante el nuevo Año litúrgico de Gracia, 2023, leeremos del ciclo del lectionario dominical del año A y del año 1 del lectionario de lunes a viernes.

¡Bendito Adviento para todos!

## THE ADVENT WREATH



The Advent Wreath is a tradition related to Advent, the Church season immediately preceding Christmas. The Advent Wreath is a popular tradition among many Christians, Catholic and Protestant. It is often used in homes, churches, and schools.

The Advent wreath, first used as a Christian devotion in the Middle Ages, gets its design from the customs of pre-Christian Germanic and Scandinavian cultures, who used candles and greenery as symbols of light and life during winter. The Advent Wreath is a circular evergreen wreath with four or five candles, three purple, one rose, and (if you use the five-candle model), one white one for Christmas Day placed in the center. Some Christians use blue candles instead of purple.

The candles symbolize the light of Christ coming into the world. The evergreen symbolizes renewal, and the circular shape symbolizes the completeness of God. The candle colors are derived from the traditional liturgical colors of Advent (purple and rose) and Christmas (white). Each candle is first lit on the appropriate Sunday of Advent, and then the candles may be lit each day as a part of the individual or family's daily prayers.

Certain candles have been given various names and designations:

- Candle 1. Hope and/or Patriarchs (purple)
- Candle 2. Peace and/or Prophets (purple)
- Candle 3. Joy and/or John the Baptist (rose)
- Candle 4. Love or The Virgin Mary (purple)
- Candle 5. Christ The Light of the World (white)

### Advent Week One

**Directions:** Light the first purple candle.

**Prayer:** Stir up Your power, O Lord, and come, that by Your protection we may be rescued from the dangers that beset us through our sins; and be a Redeemer to deliver us; Who lives and reigns with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, ever one God, world without end.

Amen.

### Alternate/Complementary Prayer:

O Emmanuel, King and Lawgiver, Desire of the nations, Savior of all people, Come and set us free, Lord, our God.

## LA CORONA DE ADVIENTO

La Corona de Adviento es una tradición relacionada con el Adviento, la temporada de la Iglesia inmediatamente anterior a la Navidad. La Corona de Adviento es una tradición popular entre muchos cristianos, católicos y protestantes. A menudo se usa en hogares, iglesias y escuelas.

La corona de Adviento, utilizada por primera vez como devoción cristiana en la Edad Media, obtiene su diseño de las costumbres de las culturas germánicas y escandinavas precrhistianas, que usaban velas y vegetación como símbolos de luz y vida durante el invierno. La Corona de Adviento es una corona circular de hoja perenne con cuatro o cinco velas, tres púrpuras, una rosa y (si usa el modelo de cinco velas), una blanca para el día de Navidad colocada en el centro. Algunos cristianos usan velas azules en lugar de púrpura.

Las velas simbolizan la luz de Cristo viniendo al mundo. El siempre verde simboliza la renovación, y la forma circular simboliza la plenitud de Dios. Los colores de las velas se derivan de los colores litúrgicos tradicionales del Adviento (púrpura y rosa) y la Navidad (blanco). Cada vela se enciende primero en el domingo apropiado de Adviento, y luego las velas se pueden encender cada día como parte de las oraciones diarias del individuo o la familia.

Ciertas velas han recibido varios nombres y designaciones:

- Vela 1. Esperanza y/o Patriarcas (morado)
- Vela 2. Paz y/o Profetas (púrpura)
- Vela 3. Alegría y/o Juan el Bautista (rosa)
- Vela 4. Amor o La Virgen María (púrpura)
- Vela 5. Cristo La Luz del Mundo (blanco)

### Primera Semana de Adviento

**Modo de empleo:** Enciende la primera vela morada.

**Oración:** Despierta Tu poder, oh Señor, y ven, para que por Tu protección podamos ser rescatados de los peligros que nos acosan a través de nuestros pecados; y ser un Redentor para librarnos; Que vive y reina con Dios Padre en la unidad del Espíritu Santo, siempre un solo Dios, mundo sin fin. Amén.

Oh Emmanuel, Rey y Legislador, Deseo de las naciones, Salvador de todas las personas, Ven y libéranos, Señor, nuestro Dios.

## THE SEASON OF ADVENT

What are we really waiting for during Advent? The longstanding tradition of the Church is that the Advent season really marks not one but three comings of Christ: his coming into history two thousand years ago, his coming in glory at the end of time, and his coming into our hearts here and now. Advent starts with a focus on the future coming of Christ so that we might see the big picture. If Christmas is to make any sense at all, we have to ask the question, "What are you doing to get ready for the (final) coming of Christ?" This perspective opens us up to the sense of anticipation experienced by the Jewish people on the eve of the first coming of Christ. This Advent, we will hear John the Baptist tell them (and us) how best to prepare. He urges repentance and an examination and reform of our way of life.

Then on the Fourth Sunday, we are drawn in to the history of Jesus' arrival as the child of Joseph and Mary. Our work of spiritual preparation brings us to the point of the whole season. What good is it that Christ comes into my heart if I don't then carry that presence out into the world, just as Mary did?

## EL TIEMPO DE ADVIENTO

¿Qué es lo que realmente esperamos durante el Adviento? La tradición de la Iglesia es que el tiempo de Adviento no marca una, sino tres venidas de Cristo: su llegada a la historia hace dos mil años, su venida en gloria al final de los tiempos, y su venida a nuestros corazones aquí y ahora. El Adviento comienza centrándose en la futura venida de Cristo para que podamos ver el panorama general. Para que la Navidad tenga algún sentido, tenemos que preguntarnos: "¿Qué estás haciendo para prepararte para la venida (final) de Cristo?" Esta perspectiva nos abre al sentido de anticipación que experimentó el pueblo judío en la víspera de la primera venida de Cristo. En este Adviento, escucharemos a Juan el Bautista decirles (y a nosotros) cuál es la mejor manera de prepararse. Insta al arrepentimiento, al examen y a la reforma de nuestro modo de vida.

Luego, el Cuarto Domingo de Adviento, nos adentramos en la historia de la llegada de Jesús como hijo de José y María. Nuestro trabajo de preparación espiritual nos lleva al punto de toda la temporada. ¿De qué sirve que Cristo entre en mi corazón si luego no llevo esa presencia al mundo, como hizo María?

## ANNUAL 7TH GRADE ECOSYSTEM PROJECT

As part of Mr. Conley's junior high STEM curriculum, our 7th graders always learn about ecosystems. They then go on to design and build an ecosystem in the science lab! Initial design concepts are drawn out by each student and then, the whole class works together to pick the best parts of each design and compile those into one final ecosystem design. They choose materials (donated by parents), determine sizes needed for each individual piece, and they even use power drills to create pilot holes and screw pieces together. When they run into problems with their designs, they go back to the drawing board and improve their design. The ecosystem always involves a system of water being pumped around from the various parts of the ecosystem. Plants and grasses are grown and/or transplanted and grown under lights. They even include fish...and this year a frog has been added!

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

**BAPTISMS:** Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents and godparents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office or website.

**RECONCILIATION:** Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:** Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

### COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

**Children:** All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades, if they are not in a Catholic School.

**Adults:** Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:** Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

### MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

**FUNERALS:** When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

**FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN:** Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceanera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

**PRESENTATION OF A CHILD:** When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

**GLUTEN FREE HOSTS:** If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.
