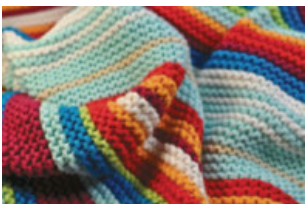
OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY WOMEN'S CLUB

GUADALUPANO COMMITTEE TAMALE SALE

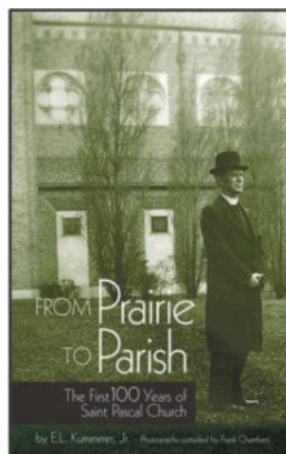

Venerable Alphonse Gallegos

Venerable Bishop Alphonse Gallegos was the auxiliary bishop of Sacramento, California, in the 1980s. He would often serve those in need wearing a cheap sombrero and simple t-shirt to fit in. His kindness caused his community to affectionately name him Bishop of the Barrios.

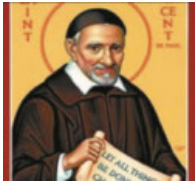

How Common is Domestic Violence?



17th Annual Domestic Violence Counts Report 2023 – Illinois Summary

On September 7, 2022, 49 out of 57 (86%) IL domestic violence programs participated in a national count of domestic violence services conducted by the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV). These statistics represent the the services they provided during the 24-hour survey period.

2,626 Victims Served

1,287 adult and child victims of domestic violence found refuge in emergency shelters, transitional housing, hotels, motels, or other housing provided by local domestic violence programs.

1,339 adult and child victims received non-residential supportive services related to legal needs, housing advocacy, transportation, mental health, public benefits, and more.

975 Hotline Contacts Received

Domestic violence hotlines are lifelines for victims in danger, providing support, information, safety planning, & resources via phone, chat, text, and email. Hotline staff received 975 contacts, averaging nearly 41 per hour.

199 People Educated

Local domestic violence programs provided 19 public training sessions (educational sessions provided to the public) to 199 people, addressing topics like domestic violence prevention and early intervention.

589 Unmet Requests for Services

Victims made 589 requests for services that programs could not provide because they did not have the resources. Approximately 28% of these unmet requests were for emergency shelter, hotels, motels, and other housing.

Informe Anual de Conteo de Violencia Doméstica 2023 - Resúmen de Illinois

El 7 de septiembre de 2022, 49 de 57 (86%) programas de violencia doméstica de Illinois participaron en un conteo nacional de servicios de violencia doméstica realizado por la Red Nacional para Acabar con la Violencia Doméstica (NNEDV, por sus siglas en inglés). Estas estadísticas representan los servicios que proporcionaron durante el período de 24 horas de la encuesta.

2.626 víctimas atendidas

1.287 adultos y niños víctimas de violencia doméstica encontraron refugio en albergues de emergencia, viviendas de transición, hoteles, moteles u otras viviendas proporcionadas por programas locales contra la violencia doméstica. 1.339 víctimas adultas y menores recibieron servicios de apoyo no residenciales relacionados con necesidades legales, defensa de la vivienda, transporte, salud mental, beneficios públicos, etc.

975 contactos con líneas de emergencia

Las líneas de emergencia de violencia doméstica son salvavidas para las víctimas en peligro, ya que proporcionan apoyo, información, planificación de la seguridad y recursos por teléfono, chat, mensajes de texto y correo electrónico. El personal de las líneas directas recibió 975 contactos, con un promedio de casi 41 por hora.

199 personas informadas

Los programas locales contra la violencia doméstica impartieron 19 sesiones de formación pública (sesiones educativas ofrecidas al público) a 199 personas, abordando temas como la prevención de la violencia doméstica y la intervención temprana.

589 solicitudes de servicios no atendidas

Las víctimas presentaron 589 solicitudes de servicios que los programas no pudieron prestar por falta de recursos. Aproximadamente el 28% de estas solicitudes insatisfechas fueron para refugio de emergencia, hoteles, moteles.

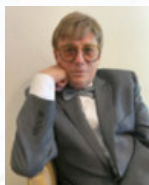
