

MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE



Dear Parishioners,

A new Academic year has begun for the children of Pope Francis Global Academy, the Parish School of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish. We start the year with more than two

hundred students, with a healthy mix of students from both Pope Francis and Saint Bartholomew, graced with a considerable number of newcomers. Our wonderful Principal, Mrs. Nilma Osiecki, and her enthusiastic faculty welcomed our students back to school on our first day, Monday, August 21. We anticipate many blessings at Pope Francis this year.

Even as the school began its new year, I was busy gathering data on the parish from the previous year. Each year at this time, the Archdiocese asks pastors to submit what has been traditionally called the "Status Animarum," a summary of the religious services and sacraments received during the past fiscal year. Between July 1, 2022, and July 1, 2023, Our Lady of the Rosary Parish baptized one hundred and five children under the age of seven. Eleven children over the age of seven were baptized, as well as five adults. We had no professions of faith from adults who had been baptized in other Christian churches.

During the past fiscal year, one hundred and twenty-three children under the age of eighteen received their First Holy Communion at Our Lady of the Rosary. Five people over the age of eighteen also received First Communion.

One hundred and one young people and seven adults were confirmed this past year at Our Lady of the Rosary. Twenty-seven marriages were celebrated. One hundred and twenty-seven funerals were provided. Among the funerals over which we presided, eighty-two concluded with burial and forty-five with cremation.

Although Labor Day is just around the corner, we are still in the midst of summer. Enjoy these final days of the season. I look forward to sharing with you an abundance of blessings in the Fall.

MENSAJE DEL PADRE MIKE



Estimados feligreses,

Un nuevo año académico ha comenzado para los niños de Pope Francis Global Academy, la Escuela Parroquial de Nuestra Señora del Rosario. Comenzamos el año con más de doscientos estudiantes, con una

mezcla saludable de estudiantes tanto del Papa Francisco como de San Bartolomé, agraciados con un número considerable de recién llegados. Nuestra maravillosa directora, la Sra. Nilma Osiecki, y su entusiasta facultad dieron la bienvenida a nuestros estudiantes a la escuela en nuestro primer día, el lunes 21 de agosto. Anticipamos muchas bendiciones en el Papa Francisco este año.

Incluso cuando la escuela comenzó su nuevo año, estaba ocupado recopilando datos sobre la parroquia del año anterior. Cada año en este momento, la Arquidiócesis pide a los pastores que presenten lo que tradicionalmente se ha llamado el "Status Animarum", un resumen de los servicios religiosos y sacramentos recibidos durante el último año fiscal. Entre el 1 de julio de 2022 y el 1 de julio de 2023, la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario bautizó a 105 niños menores de siete años. Once niños mayores de siete años fueron bautizados, así como cinco adultos. No teníamos profesiones de fe de adultos que habían sido bautizados en otras iglesias cristianas.

Durante el año fiscal pasado, 123 niños menores de dieciocho años recibieron su Primera Comunión en Nuestra Señora del Rosario. Cinco personas mayores de dieciocho años también recibieron la Primera Comunión.

101 jóvenes y siete adultos fueron confirmados el año pasado en Nuestra Señora del Rosario. Se celebraron veintisiete matrimonios. Se ofrecieron 127 funerales. Entre los funerales que presidimos, ochenta y dos concluyeron con entierro y cuarenta y cinco con cremación.

Aunque el Día del Trabajo está a la vuelta de la esquina, todavía estamos en medio del verano. Disfruta de estos últimos días de la temporada. Espero compartir con ustedes una abundancia de bendiciones en el otoño.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Isn't it a bit weird that Catholics call the Pope "papa," father? This Sunday provides us with essential Scriptural background on the papacy, the petrine office. Jesus gives Peter the "keys to the kingdom of heaven," after witnessing to the special grace Peter has to know Jesus' true identity. Many have pointed out that the "keys" refer back to the figure of Eliakim, King David's prime minister. True enough. But notice this is not mere authority or power. It's a family relationship. The Lord says to Eliakim, "He shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem" (Isaiah 22:21). David's prime minister was a spiritual father to the family of Israel. Peter, and his successors, will be spiritual fathers in the family of the Church.

This means we have a serious obligation to not only recognize the Pope's authority, but also to love him with the affection of children for their papa. We should never speak about him with disrespect or rancor. We should listen to him with trusting hearts, and ignore the slander thrown at him in various media. When we show the world we are loving and obedient to our Holy Papa, perhaps they'll see more clearly that the Church is indeed God's beloved family.





There can be no perfect democracy curtailed by color, race, or poverty." Let us act on this truth.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Fifteen-sixteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceañera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.
