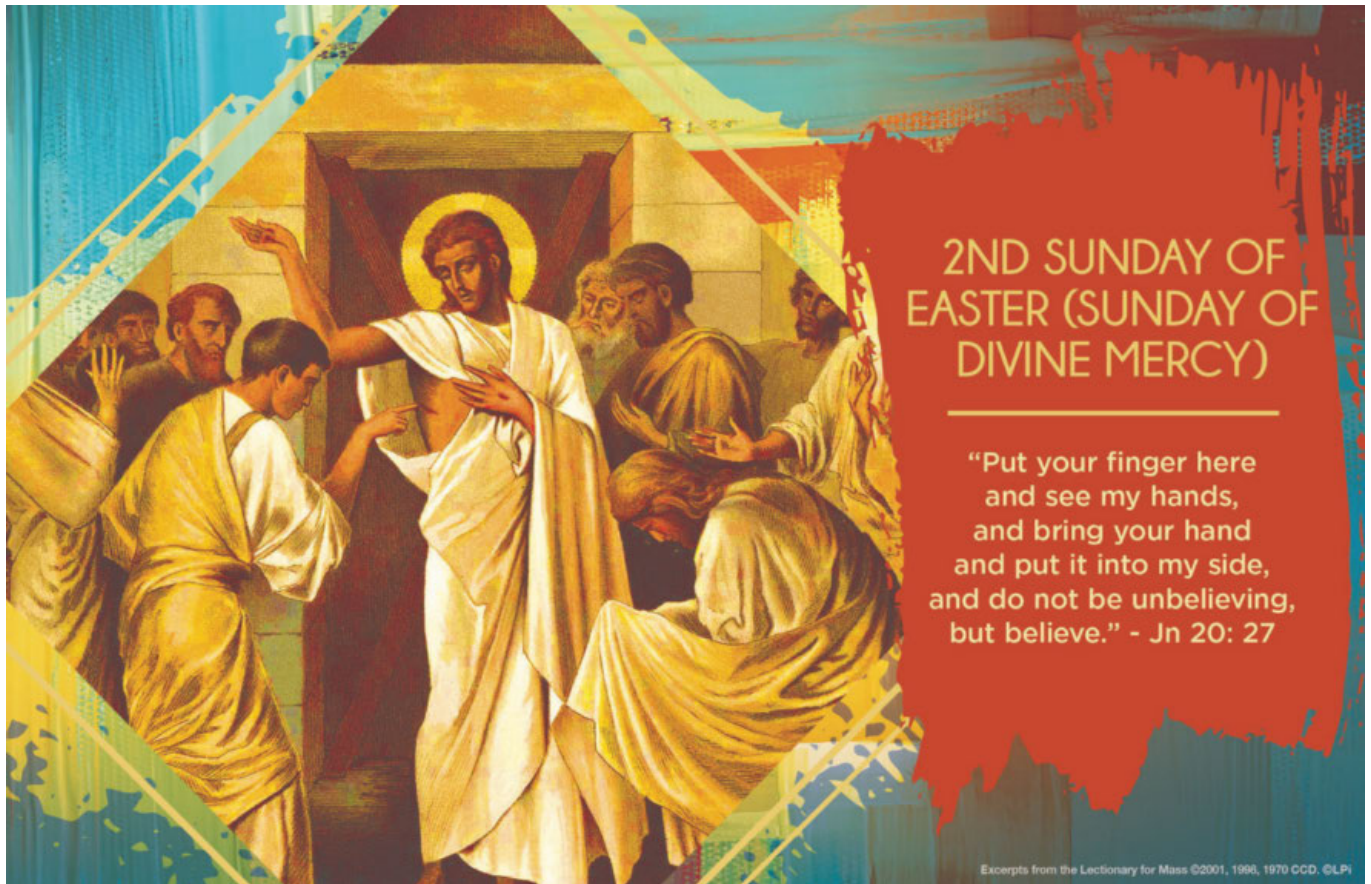

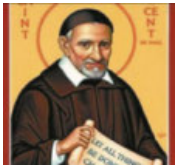

All women of the parish are welcome to attend these events.

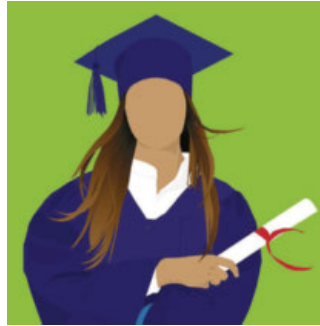

Scholarship



Our Lady of the Rosary Women's Club is fortunate to be able to offer a one-time scholarship (amount to be determined) to an eighth-grade girl from Saint Bartholomew or Saint Pascal who plans to attend a Catholic high school in the fall of 2024. - 54 Million Americans report they have been victims of Domestic Violence. (*Number represents % of U.S. population ages 15+.*)
- 60% of Americans know a victim of domestic violence or sexual assault.
- 73% of parents with children under the age of 18 said they have not talked with them about domestic violence or sexual assault.
- Even though 75% of Americans say they would act to help a stranger being abused, the reality is most people do not help.
- But 64% of Americans say if we talk more about domestic violence and sexual assault, it would make it easier to help someone.

- 73% de los padres con niños con menos de 18 años han dicho que habían hablado con ellos sobre violencia doméstica o asalto sexual.
- Aunque 75% de Americanos digan que actuarían para ayudar a un desconocido que necesitaba ayuda por ser abusado, la realidad es que casi todas las personas no ayudarían.
- Pero 64% de los Americanos dicen que si habláramos de violencia doméstica y el asalto sexual, nos lo haría más fácil para ayudar a las víctimas..

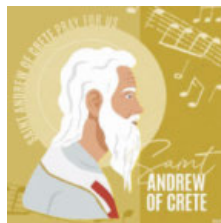

WORD OF THE WEEK

Annunciation \ə-ˌnɛn-sē-ā-shən\

From Latin, “to bring news,” the angelic proclamation to Mary of Nazareth that she would be the mother of Jesus. Mary’s submission to this divine plan is simply given: “Let it be done to me according to your word” (Luke 1:38). Her “yes” is often referred to as Mary’s fiat (Latin for “let it be done”).

The mystery of the Annunciation reveals the depth of God’s love for us, and His desire to be in relationship with us.

The importance of the Annunciation is underscored by the fact that this is the first mystery of the Rosary and is celebrated by the Angelus as well.

WHY IT MATTERS

Unlike many saving acts that are unilaterally achieved by the divine will, in the Annunciation a woman is invited to participate in the saving event that has consequences for all people and all time. Mary’s yes is universal and limitless. At the Annunciation, Mary perfectly consents to God’s will, then bears the Son, and is filled with the Spirit, which, as theologian Hans Urs von Balthasar notes, is wholly trinitarian.

From Pope Paul VI’s *Marialis Cultus* (“Devotion to Mary”): [The Annunciation observance] was and is a joint one of Christ and of the Blessed Virgin: of the Word, who becomes Son of Mary, and of the Virgin, who becomes Mother of God.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What do I need to know about Mary?

There is the biblical Mary of Nazareth, who fulfills Isaiah’s Emmanuel prophecy by giving birth to a child who is “God with us.” Her Magnificat canticle foreshadows Jesus’ proclamation that the mighty will be brought down while the poor are lifted up. Mary plays other noteworthy roles: advocating for a miracle at Cana, being present at the cross, and participating in the Spirit’s reception at Pentecost. Finally, as Mary is the first disciple of her son, she is the ideal model for all of us.

The church teaches four doctrines about Mary. Two declarations declare her a virgin as well as the Mother of God. Two later doctrines teach that Mary was conceived immaculately (sinless) and that, at the point of death, was assumed body and soul to heaven.

Devotionally, Mary plays a large role in popular piety. Her icon has been venerated since the early centuries in the East. By means of the Rosary, litanies, and pilgrimage, people of many lands feel a special closeness to the mother of Jesus who is mother to all.
