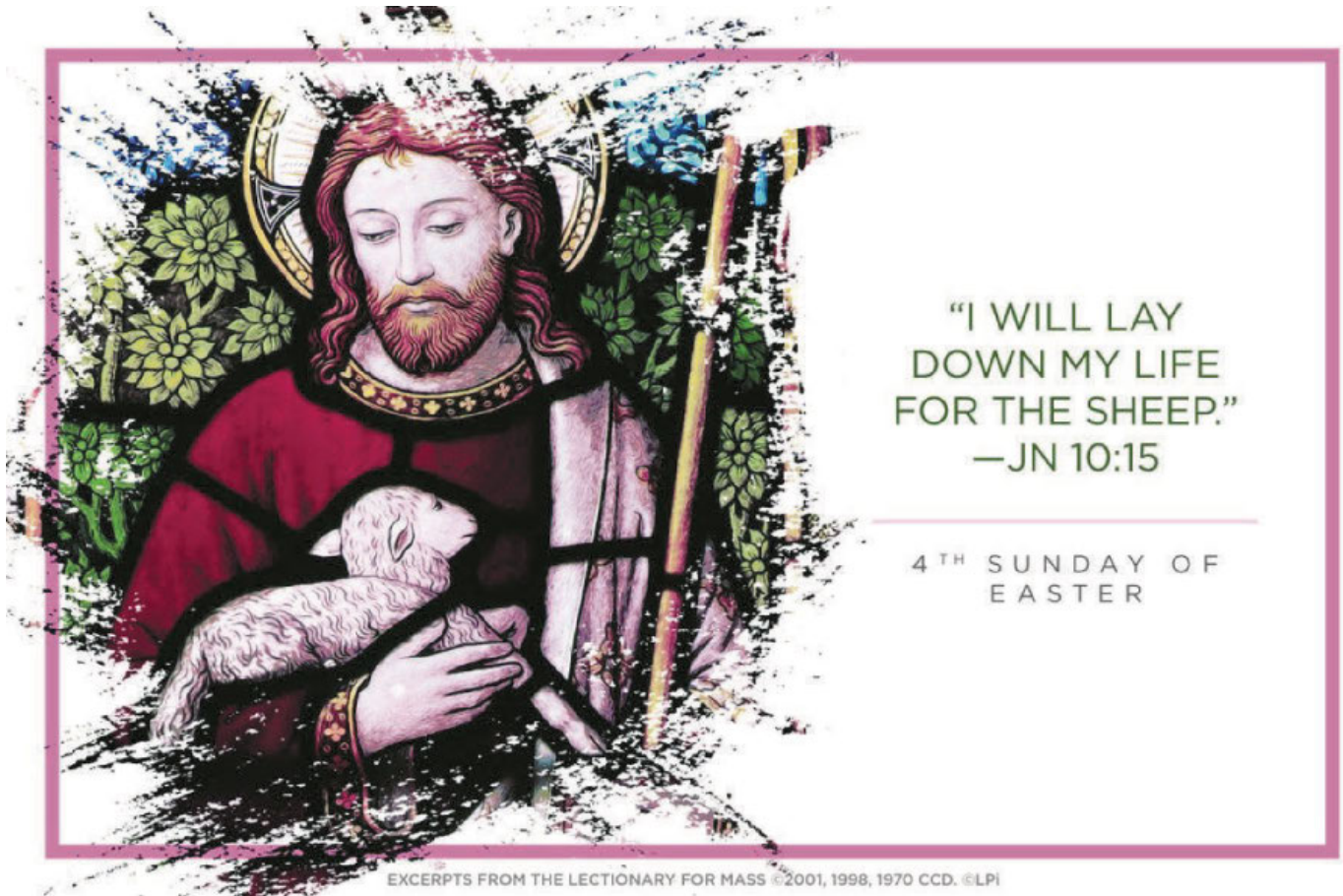

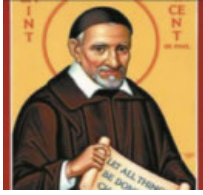

## Gospel Meditation

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know Him and His willingness to die for us! This week He says, "I know my own and my own know me," and "I lay down my life for the sheep." Here we encounter an insanelly excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down His life for you and me — and He has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and His saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about His love. He never ceases to lay down His life for us.

¿Quiénes son nuestros pastores hoy en día? ¿Qué voces escuchamos? ¿A quién seguimos o hacemos caso? En una parte de la sociedad tan materializada, que busca el poder personal olvidándose de los que lo rodean y envuelta en la tecnología tan avanzada, es casi imposible distinguir al buen Pastor. Ensimismada en sí misma y en sus caprichos egoístas se aleja fácilmente de la verdad y la justicia tan necesarias para el acercamiento al pastoreo de Jesús por medio de su Palabra. Sin embargo, si ponemos atención en medio de la vida cotidiana, nos daremos cuenta que sí existen pastores que arriesgan la vida por sus ovejas. Como ejemplo vivo, tenemos al Obispo de la Diócesis de Matagalpa, Nicaragua, Monseñor Rolando Álvarez condenado a 26 años de cárcel por decir la verdad y buscar la justicia para su comunidad.

El Papa Francisco como nuestro máximo Pastor nos invita a ir hacia nosotros mismos y reflexionar en lo siguiente: "Queridos hermanos y hermanas: en este tiempo, muchos pensamientos y preocupaciones nos llevan a volver y a adentrarnos en nosotros mismos. Prestemos atención a las voces que llegan a nuestros corazones. Preguntémonos de dónde vienen. Pidamos la gracia de reconocer y seguir la voz del buen Pastor, que nos saca del redil del egoísmo y nos guía hacia los pastos de la verdadera libertad (05-03-2020). En este domingo hagamos nuestras las palabras de Jesús y sigamos su ejemplo de guiar a los que amamos por el buen camino. "El buen Pastor da su vida por las ovejas" (Juan 10:11)

## Leyendo la Biblia

*¿Qué es único o diferente en la forma en que los católicos leen y están expuestos a la Biblia?*

Los católicos están expuestos a las Escrituras principalmente a través de las lecturas dominicales de un libro conocido como el Leccionario. El Leccionario es un libro de pasajes seleccionados de la Biblia ambientados en el contexto de un tiempo litúrgico, como el Adviento, la Cuaresma o el tiempo ordinario. Hay cuatro lecturas asignadas a cualquier domingo: la primera lectura (generalmente del Antiguo Testamento), el salmo responsorial, la segunda lectura (generalmente de una carta del Nuevo Testamento) y la lectura del Evangelio.

Estas lecturas juntas les dan un nuevo contexto. Las lecturas seleccionadas se relacionan entre sí de una manera única que no está presente en el texto bíblico mismo. Al estar muy cerca unas de otras, estas lecturas ahora tienen la oportunidad de conversar entre sí de una manera que antes no hubiera sido posible. Un homilista presta atención a las cuatro lecturas, preparando una reflexión que habla de esta conversación entre las lecturas, permitiéndonos concentrarnos en lo que esta combinación única de la palabra de Dios tiene para decirnos este domingo en particular.

La próxima vez que asistas a la liturgia dominical, intenta leer las Escrituras con anticipación y observa cómo esta nueva relación entre las lecturas te dirige y te desafía a ser un mejor cristiano aquí y ahora.

## Reading the Bible

*What is unique or different about the way Catholics read and are exposed to the Bible?*

Catholics are exposed to Scripture primarily through the Sunday readings from a book known as the Lectionary. The Lectionary is a book of selected passages from the Bible set in the context of a liturgical season, such as Advent, Lent, or ordinary time. There are four readings assigned to any Sunday: the first reading (usually from the Old Testament), the responsorial psalm, the second reading (usually from a New Testament letter), and the Gospel reading.

These readings together give them a new context. The selected readings relate to one another in a unique manner that is not present in the Bible text itself. In close proximity to each other, these readings now have the opportunity to converse with each other in a way that would have not been possible before. A homilist pays attention to all four readings, preparing a reflection that speaks of this conversation among the readings, enabling us to zero in on what this unique combination of God's word has to say to us this particular Sunday.

Next time you attend Sunday liturgy, try reading the Scripture ahead of time and see how this new relationship among the readings addresses and challenges you to be a better Christian here and now.

## WORD OF THE WEEK

### Evangelist *li-'van-jə-list*

One who announces Good News, particularly the message of the gospel. Often refers exclusively to the four gospel writers Mark, Matthew, Luke, and John. The New Testament also uses this term in reference to Philip, the deacon, and Timothy, a worker with Paul.

### CONTEXT

Evangelizers take on the “smell of the sheep” and the sheep are willing to hear their voice. —*Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium*

We are all evangelists, but we almost always evangelize about the wrong things. —*Matthew Kelly*

Saint Juan Diego, the peasant to whom Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared, is essentially the evangelizer of an entire hemisphere. —*USCCB.org*

### WHY IT MATTERS

We All Christians are summoned to the role of evangelists, a term first used in reference to the gospel writers in the third century. As followers of Jesus, our common vocation is to bring Good News to the poor, sick, lonely, imprisoned, and socially marginalized. The words of the four primary evangelists—Mark, Matthew, Luke, and John—instruct us in the mission we’re invited to share.

From *Evangelii Nuntiandi* (Evangelization in the Modern World): The world is calling for evangelizers to speak to it of a God whom the evangelists themselves should know and be familiar with [122].

## QUESTION OF THE WEEK

### What is an evangelist?

Evangelist translates from Greek as “messenger of good tidings.” All baptized persons are called to be such messengers. Isaiah speaks of the “beautiful feet” of those who bring Good News. Ephesians describes apostles, prophets, and evangelists as central players in the church. Biblically, evangelist is not an exclusive term.

By the third century, the formal list of evangelists is reduced to the four gospel writers, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. They concretized the Good News the church would proclaim going forward.

By the fourth century, the symbology of the four evangelists became standardized as man, lion, ox, and eagle. Facing the four directions, these extraordinary creatures are four and yet unified in movement. They also burn like hot coals. Matthew, whose gospel emphasizes Jesus’ humanity, is represented by the man. Mark highlights Jesus’ divinity and kingship, so is identified as the lion. Luke holds up the sacrificial role of Jesus and so becomes the ox. John is the eagle as his gospel soars with a transcendent perspective on Jesus as the Christ.
