MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE



Dear Parishioners

On Thursday, November 23, we observe our national Day of Thanksgiving. At Our Lady of the Rosary Parish, we will offer our Mass of Thanksgiving on Thursday morning, November 23

at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal Church. The Mass will be offered as a bilingual liturgy and will feature musical selections from our choirs. The 9:00 AM Mass at Saint Pascal will be the only Mass that we offer on Thanksgiving. We pray that as many of our parishioners as possible will join us for this festive celebration of the Eucharist.

As you know, the very word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving. Hence, it is most appropriate for Catholics to gather for the Mass on Thanksgiving morning. Although Thanksgiving is not a "Day of Precept," that is a Holy Day of Obligation, the very nature of the holiday lends itself to the desire to participate in the Mass. I have always found the Mass we celebrate on Thanksgiving morning to be among the most moving of our celebrations. When I was a student in Europe, I truly missed the experience of Thanksgiving morning Mass. I remember once travelling to Paris from Rome to celebrate the holiday with some cousins who were in France at the time. Because these relatives were not particularly religious, I went alone to a late morning Mass at the great Cathedral of Notre Dame. Of course, the Mass was not the Mass we offer in the United States on Thanksgiving Day. It was simply the Mass offered on a weekday in Ordinary Time. But the Americans present seemed to recognize one another. At the Exchange of Peace, we happily wished one another a Happy Thanksgiving.

As we gather to offer our thanks to Almighty God for his abundant blessings, I wish all of you and your loved ones a very Happy Thanksgiving. I realize that Thanksgiving morning can be a very busy time for families. But, if you are able to join us, I would especially grateful.

Again, Thanksgiving Blessings to you and all those whom you love!

El jueves 23 de noviembre de 2023 celebramos nuestro Día Nacional de Acción de Gracias. En la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora del Rosario, ofreceremos nuestra Misa de Acción de Gracias el jueves 23 de noviembre por la mañana a las 9:00 a.m. en la Iglesia de San Pascal. La Misa se ofrecerá como una liturgia bilingüe y contará con selecciones musicales de nuestros coros. La Misa de las 9:00 AM en St. Pascal será la única Misa que ofreceremos en el Día de Acción de Gracias. Debido a que estos parientes no eran particularmente religiosos, fui solo a una misa matutina en la gran catedral de Notre Dame. Por supuesto, la Misa no fue la Misa que ofrecemos en los Estados Unidos en el Día de Acción de Gracias. Era simplemente la Misa ofrecida en un día laborable del Tiempo Ordinario. Pero los estadounidenses presentes parecían reconocerse unos a otros. En el Intercambio de Paz, nos deseamos felizmente un feliz Día de Acción de Gracias.

Mientras nos reunimos para dar gracias a Dios Todopoderoso por sus abundantes bendiciones, les deseo a todos ustedes y a sus seres queridos un muy feliz Día de Acción de Gracias. Me doy cuenta de que la mañana del Día de Acción de Gracias puede ser un momento muy ocupado para las familias. Pero, si puedes unirte a nosotros, te lo agradecería especialmente.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

When I was a kid, I hated playing Monopoly because my siblings and friends always seemed to win. But worse was how it happened. Scared to risk my fake money on buying properties, I'd hold on to it. My opponents hungrily bought up the various real estate squares on the board. Then, inevitably, my poor, low-equity self would land on their spots, pay them rent, and my money would drain to zero. It seemed so unfair. The rich get richer, and the poor get poorer. I had to learn that monopoly money is meant to be spent. I was scared to lose some of it. So, I lost all of it.

How do we see what we possess? Jesus' parable about the talents is not really about economics but about the investability of everything he entrusts to us. How marvelous that everyone in the fable who places talents in the open market doubles their investment. The only one who doesn't is the man who fearfully buries his one talent. Jesus' success strategy for us seems to be, whatever we have, get it out of our possession. Risk it as quickly and as fully as we can.

You and I have precious gifts. We have valuable things to invest — time, talents, treasure. The Lord invites us to be brave and even somewhat reckless, to give as much away as possible. If we give it away in the direction of love and truth, it will grow. If we hold on to it in fear, the little we have will be taken away. Let me challenge you this week: find something in your life you're holding on to, and risk it by giving it away. It won't double if you hold on to it.—

Pablo hace una invitación personal para vivir confiados en el encuentro definitivo con el Señor. *"Todos ustedes son hijos de la luz e hijos del día: no somos de la noche ni de las tinieblas"* (Tosalonicenses 5:3). El Evangelio hace hincapié en los talentos que Dios nos ha regalado, pues sobre ellos daremos cuenta a Dios. ¿Qué regalos he recibido de Dios? ¿Cómo los hago producir? Existe un regalo de Dios para todos y es universal, se llama amor.

Señor, ayúdame a hacer crecer los regalos que me has dado. Que sepa compartir lo que soy y lo que tengo, que no sea egoísta, ni estéril en mis propósitos. También, ayúdame a ayudar a mi familia y amigos que han enterrado sus talentos por miedo a perder y equivocarse. *"Todos hemos recibido de Dios un patrimonio como seres humanos, una riqueza humana, del tipo que sea. Y como discípulos de Cristo, también hemos recibido la fe, el Evangelio, el Espíritu Santo, los sacramentos, y tantas otras cosas. Estos dones hay que emplearlos para hacer el bien, el bien en esta vida, como servicio a Dios y a los hermanos"* (Papa Francisco 11-15-2020). 

Cultivate these in your own life by praying the Virtues of Mary chaplet used by the Marian religious order since 1699.

No room for violence

On this day in 1960 a trio of courageous sisters was brutally assassinated for opposing the murderous regime of Dominican dictator Rafael Trujillo. Since 1993, the U.N. has commemorated World Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women in honor of the Mirabal sisters. It is an appropriate coincidence that today we also honor Catherine of Alexandria, a young convert martyred at the tender age of 18 during Roman persecutions around the year 300. She was reportedly subject to terrible tortures, but her courage instead attracted hundreds more converts. No woman should have to endure violence for any reason. Today is a day we can honor martyrs both modern and ancient with a firm "No más, no more."

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades, if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message or press option 5.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office if there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Fifteen-sixteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceanera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.

PREPARACIÓN SACRAMENTAL
